The Czech Republic is the most developed market economy among the former communist countries in central Europe with a higher per capita income than Portugal. It is often described as a sophisticated, stable and prosperous market.

Like many other European countries, the Czech Republic has not been untouched by the current economic turmoil, but it has managed to avoid the melt-down that affected other countries in the region. Although its economy is expected to contract by 3% in 2009, it is forecast to recover from 2010 onwards with an estimated GDP growth of 1.2%.

Many sectors such as education, training, construction, science and innovation, present a wide range of opportunities for UK companies. The country has also strong scientific, manufacturing and engineering traditions that offer potential for manufacturing co-operation and niche exports in the automotive and aerospace sectors.

The UK and the Czech Republic have excellent trade relations. In 2008, bilateral trade was worth £5bn. The UK is the Czech Republic's seventh most important commercial partner and it is responsible for approximately 4% of total FDI in the country.
