
Bidding Items & Guidelines

ITEM 1: Míla Fürstová - Zlatý kolovrat, KYTICE, (blue on white), etching, 56x64cm, 2020



- 21 November 2020 marks 150th anniversary of Czech poet's Karel Jaromír Erben's death. He is best known for his collection of poems Kytice (Bouquet). Mila was asked to illustrate the new Czech and English translated edition coming to UK bookstores soon. This obtained quite some attention from the press, and not only in the Czech Republic.

ITEM 2: Jakub Hrůša – signed conductor's baton





- Jakub Hrůša is Chief Conductor of the Bamberg Symphony, Principal Guest Conductor of the Philharmonia Orchestra, and Principal Guest Conductor of the Czech Philharmonic. He is a frequent guest with many of the world's greatest orchestras.
- Recent highlights of performances include debuts with the Vienna Philharmonic, Orchestre de Paris, and the NHK Symphony.
- As a recording artist, his recent releases includ Dvořák Symphonies, for which he received recent Grammy nomination!
- Jakub Hrůša has studied conducting at the Academy of Performing Arts in Prague, where his teachers included Jiří Bělohlávek

ITEM 3: Petr Čech – signed goal keeper's gloves



- Czech professional footballer combining playing and being technical and performance advisor for Chelsea.
- Without any doubt the best goal-keeper of his time, Petr Čech started his professional career in Chmel Blšany in 1999, later continued in Sparta Praha, spending most of his professional career in Chelsea (2004-2015) and Arsenal (2015-2019).
- He represented the Czech Republic in 124 matches, helped the Czechs reach the semi-finals in Euro 2004 and was voted into the Euro 2004 All-Star team.
- Petr contributed his signed goal-keeping gloves.
- Minimum bidding amount of GBP 200



ITEM 4: Tomáš Souček and Vladimír Coufal - signed West Ham jersey



- Successful Czech footballers joined the West Ham United football club this year and are now pushing West Ham up the Premier League table.
- Formerly star players of Slavia Praha, both are regular members of Czech National team.
- Both contributed their signed West Ham jerseys.
- Minimum bidding amount GBP 200 per each.







ITEM 6: Professor Jan Marek – private collection photograph



- Professor Marek is currently a Lead Consultant of Echocardiography and Prenatal Cardiology at the Great Ormond Street Hospital, and Professor at the Institute of Cardiovascular Sciences at University College London (UCL) and Charles University, Prague.
- Professor Marek is a patron of this fundraiser and as a passionate photographer he kindly contributed a photo from his private collection.
- Photo dimensions: 297x430mm
- Minimum bidding amount of GBP 50.

CBCC members Christmas Fundraising Bidding Guidelines

- Start of bidding: at the moment of sending CBCC communication on Monday 30 November.
- Submitting a bid: You can submit your bid by sending an email to <u>matous@cbcc.org.uk</u>. You need to receive your bid receipt confirmation from CBCC, to make the bid registered.
- Time window for the bidding: From Tuesday 1st December to 8pm Friday 11th December 2020.
- Update on the bids submitted: CBCC will share with their contact base the progress of bidding on an ongoing basis, but no less than 2 times on Friday 4 December and Thursday 10 December. The update will include an items list with the submitted bidding amounts.
- Winning bid: The highest bid submitted by 8pm Friday 11th December wins, subject to exceeding the Minimum bidding value.
- Funds transferred: Bid amount needs to be transferred to CBCC's account no later than 15 December 2020. If not transferred the bidding items will be passed on to the second highest bidder.
- Handing over items to winners: CBCC will strive to hand over or ship the items to the winners as soon as possible. Bearing in mind that Christmas is peak time for post and deliveries, CBCC cannot be held responsible for delivering the items in time for Christmas.
- Confidentiality names of bidders will not be revealed, unless the winning bidder agrees otherwise.

CBCC commits to pass all proceeds of the fundraiser to GOSH Charity in full and will inform its members and winners of the items how they were spent.
